Date: 15 June 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (swamp). **Habitat**: *Melaleuca ericifolia* swamp forest.

Substrate outer shell of decorticated *Acacia melanoxylon* log. Description gregarious stalked sporangia, 1.5–1.7 mm high. Sporotheca globose, brown, 0.3–0.6 mm diameter. Stalk subulate, black, 1.2–1.4 mm long, fibrous at base by transmitted light. Hypothallus inconspicuous. Peridium fugacious. Columella short, divides just above stalk apex into several branches that give rise to the capillitium. Capillitium loose, slender. Spores brown in mass, light brown by transmitted light with lighter germination area, minutely warted, 9 μ m.

Notes This species appeared several times in masses covering about 120 mm x 100 mm on the northern side of an *Acacia melanoxylon* log. The log is checked regularly and is often productive. Other species collected from the log include *Arcyria* sp., *Physarum viride*, *P. nutans*, *Badhamia utricularis*, *P. album*, *Diderma* sp. and *Trichia* sp.
