Date 13 July 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track). **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: large bryophyte-covered stump north of big tree stump. **Description** gregarious and scattered stalked sporangia, to 1 mm high, orange-brown. **Sporotheca** globose, 0.5 mm diameter. **Stalk** black, grooved, 0.6 mm long; reddish brown by transmitted light. **Hypothallus** contiguous under close sporangia, membranous, reddish, shiny. **Peridium** membrane is fugacious between the net except for small calyculus in some sporangia. Approximately 15 strong ribs at base merging into net without conspicuous nodes. **Spores** orange in mass, pale by transmitted light, faintly warted, 7 μm. **Notes**: Keys out to *C. ferruginea* in Nann.-Bremek. (1991). Several collections.
