

**Date** 4 May 2011. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (home, garden).

**Habitat:** Eucalypt forest.

**Substrate** Artichoke leaf on compost heap.

**Description** Scattered sessile plasmodiocarps and stalked sporangia, 0.5 wide x 1.1 mm long; sporangia subglobose umbilicate at base 0.5–0.4 mm. **Stalk** brown, striate, widely attached to substrate, 0.2 mm high. **Peridium** white crystalline lime over darker layer. **Columella** most sporangia very hard indicating they were probably collected too early. However, inspection in 2016 reveals that most sporangia had been eaten by invertebrates revealing hemispherical, buff coloured columella. **Capillitium** sparsely branched threads with some dark nodular thickenings. **Spores** black in mass, dark brown by transmitted light, 11.5  $\mu\text{m}$ .

**Notes:** One collection only in poor condition.
