Licea minima Fries.

Date 5 Nov. 2016. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).
Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.
Substrate strongly decayed log, probably eucalypt.
Description scattered and gregarious sessile sporangia, subglobose to angular, pale brown to almost black, 0.2–0.4 mm diameter. Peridium thick, cartilaginous, opaque with prominent ridges that break into angular plates. Consists of several layers: the inner layer shiny brown by reflected light, yellow brown by transmitted light with papillose border; the outer layer with inclusions, petaloid or reflexed in older sporangia. Spores reddish brown in mass, ferruginous brown by transmitted light with pale side, warted, 10.5–12 µm.
Notes Often found in the field or among collections of other species.
