Substrate: Small fallen leaning branch near ground.

Description: Extensive colony covering over a meter mostly on the underside of the branch, 1.2 mm high. Sporotheca globose to hemispherical, nodding, umbilicate where the stalk attaches, 0.4 mm diameter, iridescent. Stalk long, sinuous, grooved, red, lighter and yellow at apex. Hypothallus membranous, shiny, inconspicuous. Peridium single layer with no lime, breaking into flakes that remain attached to the capillitium, iridescent with golden, purple and blue reflections. Columella absent. Capillitium yellow lime nodes connected by colourless threads. Spores: Brown in mass, paler by transmitted light, minutely punctate with groups of darker
