Date 12 Nov. 2012. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track). **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: Strongly decayed eucalypt branch on ground. **Description** several scattered tufts of gregarious stalked light brown sporangia, 2.5 mm high. Sporotheca sub-cylindrical, rounded at apex, tapering at base, 0.3 mm wide. Stalk approximately ½ height of sporangia, black and shiny in reflected light; translucent red in upper part with black fibrous netted base when viewed in transmitted light. Hypothallus contiguous under tufts, membranous, yellow brown, darker near stalk. Peridium some persistent patches but otherwise fugacious. Columella curved in upper part, or straight with pointed tips to 3/3 up sporotheca, red brown by transmitted light. Capillitium attached to full length of columella with membranous expansions and about 5 meshes across radius; surface net sinuous angular. **Spores** brown in mass, pale by transmitted light, reticulate pattern of faint large meshes between small dark meshes, $5-6~\mu m$.
