Comatricha sp. Preuss

Date 28 June 2016 Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track) **Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate Leaning dead eucalypt near large Banksia. Description scattered stalke sporangia 0.5–1.9 mm high. Sporotheca globose, pinkish brown, 0.2–0.3 mm diameter. Stalk subulate, black; brown and fibrous by transmitted light. Hypothallus inconspicuous Peridium membranous, fugacious Columella reaches to approximately ½ of sporotheca where it divides in two. Capillitium branches several times before periphery; free ends at periphery with some swellings, brown, 1–2 µm diameter. Spores mid brown in mass, light brown by transmitted light, minutely warted, 7.5 µm.

Notes Possibly a Paradiacheopsis sp.?
