Date 1 Nov. 2016. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (home). Habitat: Eucalypt forest. Substrate wood, firewood pile. Description scattered and gregarious stalked sporangia 0.7–2 mm high, dark brown. Sporotheca globose to sub-globose, 0.4–0.5 mm diameter. Stalk subulate (widely attached to substrate), approximately ¾–2/3 height of sporangia, black, shiny; when viewed with transmitted light stalk is fibrous and black with reticulate base. Hypothallus contiguous or discoid, membranous, colourless. Peridium fugacious? (most sporangia had lost spores). Columella ends abruptly about the centre or near apex of sporangia. Capillitium attached along length of columella, branching and anastomosing, surface net with spiny free ends, brown. Spores dark brown in mass, brown by transmitted light, sparsely warted, 9–10 μm.
