Date 3 Jan. 2013 Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (Thismia Gully). **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate decaying eucalypt log this side of Thismia Gully. Description dense group of erect, short-stalked sporangia, 1.4–1.6 mm high, dark brown. Sporotheca cylindrical, rounded at apex. Stalk very short, black. Hypothallus thick, conspicuous, shiny. Peridium fugacious Columella extends to near the apex of the sporangia. Capillitium attached at right angles and along full length of columella, open, large-meshed internal net with membranous expansions. Numerous thin, hyaline free ends. Spores brown in mass, reddish brown by transmitted light, warted, 8 μm .

Notes Rain while developing.
